Dúirt Íosa parabal leo á chur i gcéill nárbh fholáir dóibh bheith ag guí de ghnáth gan bheith cortha de choíche:

³Bhí baintreach sa chathair sin freisin agus bhíodh sí ag teacht chuige, ag rá: ‘Déan ceart dom in aghaidh fhear mo chúisithe,’

⁴ach níorbh áil leis é seal aimsire; ach sa deireadh dúirt sé ina aigne: ‘Más ea féin nach bhfuil eagla Dé orm ná beann ar dhuine agam, ⁵ina dhiaidh sin, de chionn go mbíonn an bhaintreach seo do mo bhuaireamh, déanfaidh mé ceart di, le heagla go mbeadh sí ag teacht go deo ag crá mo chinn.’ ”

Hear the Gospel....

Luke 18: 1-8

Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

Then Jesus told them a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart. ²He said, ‘In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor had respect for people. ³In that city there was a widow who kept coming to him and saying, “Grant me justice against my opponent.” ⁴For a while he refused; but later he said to himself, “Though I have no fear of God and no respect for anyone, ⁵yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will grant her justice, so that she may not wear me out by continually coming.” ’

⁶And the Lord said, ‘Listen to what the unjust judge says. ⁷And will not God grant justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them? ⁸I tell you, he will quickly grant justice to them. And yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?’

A Thiarna do phobail: bheir muid bulochas duit as ucht and tsoiscéal aspalda a tugadh do d'Eaglais; neartaigh d'Eaglais ar fud an domhain, déan saol na deoise seo a athnuachan; beannaigh Pól ár n-easpag, agus daingnigh sinn i muinín agus i ngrá. Bheir muid buíochas duit as ucht na hÁrd Eaglaise seo, Naomh Fionn Barra agus an 150 bhliain atá an foirgneamh seo againne.

A Thiarna na cruinne: bheir muid bulochas duit as ucht ord na nithe cruthaithe; dearc le fabhar ar an domhan; treoraigh na náisiúin ar shlite na córa agus na síochána, agus beannaigh ár nUachtaráin agus iad sin uile atá i gceannas, go mór mhór agus iad ag iarraidh coimhlint leis an gCovéid agus gach a bhaineann leis:

A Thiarna ár gcaidrimh: bheir muid bulochas duit as ucht na bpobal ina bhfuil muid ag maireachtáil agus ag obair; cuidigh linn seirbhís a thabhairt agus grá a bheith againn dár gcomharsana mar atá grá againn dúinn féin agus mar a thugann tusa grá dúinne.

A Thiarna gach leighis: bheir muid bulochas duit as ucht Chríost atá linn inár neart agus inár laige. Tabhair faoiseamh dóibh sin atá tinn nó ag fulaingt, agus cosain iad, bí leo sin a bhfuil díth ar leith orthu agus saor iad sin atá i gcontúirt.

A Thiarna na síoraíochta: ceangail le chéile sinn trí do Spiorad Naomh, i gcomaoin le gach duine a fuair bás faoi shíocháin Chríost ag admháil an Chreidimh, go gcuirimis sinn féin, agus a chéile agus ár saol uile i do mhuinín, a Thiarna Dia, ionas go dtagaimis le do naoimh uile go lúcháir do ríochta síoraí. **Áiméan.**
